Take bus 281 to Vrångö ferry service and hop off on beautiful Donsö island. The ferry makes the round trip every day of the week, all year round. It runs twice a day from Stenpiren in central Gothenburg, or you can take the ferry that runs more frequently from Saltholmen. Trams run to Saltholmen from the city centre and the journey takes 35 minutes. Get your fill of great food, walks through beautiful nature reserves and a chance to relax to the sounds of the sea.

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Dine in a magnificent manor house setting

Valkyria opens this season at Liseberg

Liseberg will open a new major attraction during 2018. Valkyria is Europe's longest Dive Coaster – a roller coaster with a vertical drop of a full 50 metres. Just as you are about to roll over the edge, the ride pauses, and then you fall straight down into an underground tunnel. At 105 kph!

Valkyria is part of Liseberg's new Nordic myths and legends area, which also contains Europe's highest gyro swing, Loke, which opened in 2017. Balder, Liseberg's huge wooden roller coaster, was already there. New shopping opportunities, games and restaurants are also coming to the area.

Liseberg is Sweden's largest tourist attraction, with almost 3 million visitors every year. The summer season begins on 28 April and continues until 30 September.

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Volvo Ocean Race returns to Gothenburg

Gothenburg will once again be welcoming the world's best sailors to Frihamnen – the final stop for the race before the finish. Enjoy a unique folk festival right in the heart of the city with the in-port race. The first cranes arrive in the middle of March. Around Lake Hornborga, you can experience beautiful scenery and fascinating history, enjoy locally sourced food, see cranes dance at close range, stay in unique accommodation and much more.
