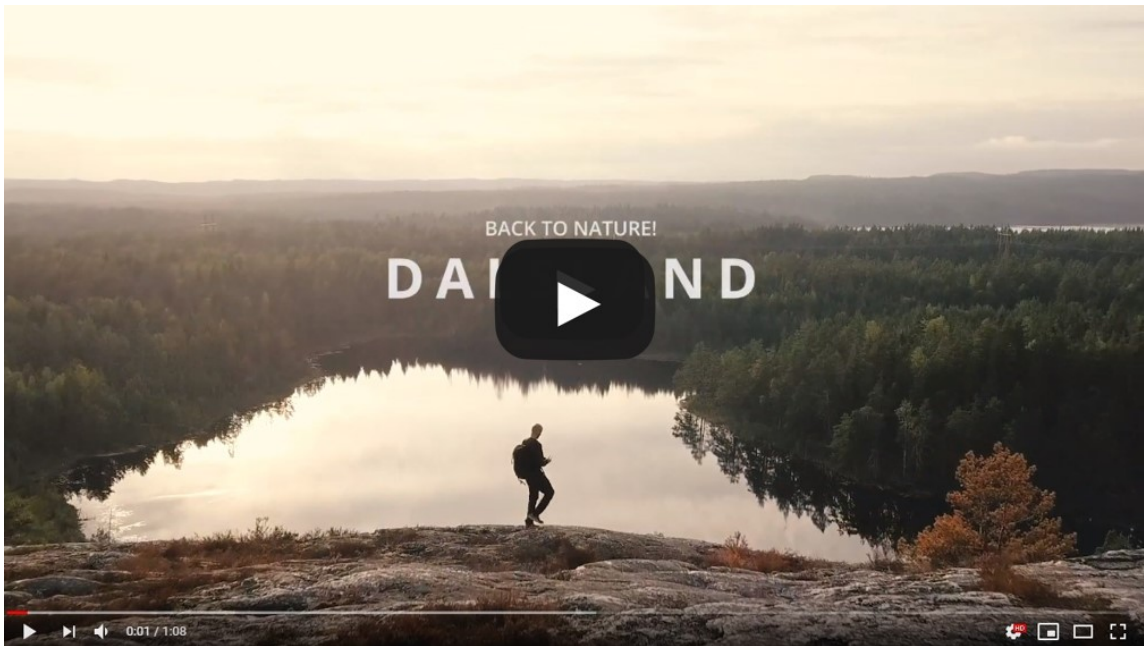

TRÄDGÅRDSRESAN - West Sweden's own Yellow Book

Trädgårdsresan (The Garden Journey) is a project with the aim of creating a West Swedish Yellow Book (National Garden Scheme visitor gardens in England) for West Swedish gardens, both private and public. During 2018 there were 13 gardens which qualified, and the aim for 2019 is to increase that to 40.

Trädgårdsresan is in the process of designing typical West Swedish gardens; one from Bohuslän, one from Dalsland and one from further inland. In addition a West Swedish garden will be planted inside Saltwell Park in the UK, and will be officially opened in August. This is as part of an exchange between Saltwell Park and Jonsered Gardens, which in their turn have an English garden designed by garden designer Susie White.
