

The Koster Islands, 45 minutes from Strömstad (which in its turn is 160 km from Gothenburg and 130 km from Oslo), are a good example. The islands are home to extensive nature reserves, such as Kosterhavet National Park, Sweden's first marine national park. You will find a beautiful mixture of coastal scenery, with beaches and meadows, heaths and woodlands, and a windswept outer archipelago.
